An appeal having been taken from an order of the Family Court, New York County, entered on or about December 16, 2025,

And respondent-appellant, pro se, having moved (1) for the immediate return of her children or in the alternative, to stay enforcement of the order entered December 16, 2025 and all Family Court proceedings except any hearing made pursuant to Family Court Act § 1061, pending hearing and determination of the appeal, (2) to dismiss the neglect complaint, and (3) for a waiver of costs, fees and expenses on appeal,

Now, upon reading and filing the papers with respect to the motion, and due deliberation having been had thereon,

It is ordered that the motion is granted to the extent of permitting the appeal to be heard on the original record and upon a reproduced appellant's brief, on condition that appellant serves one copy of such brief upon the attorney for respondent and files with this Court an original and a single unbound copy of the brief, together with the original record, in accordance with section 1250.9 of the Practice Rules of the Appellate Division. Appellant is permitted to dispense with payment of the required fee for the subpoena and filing of the record.

If respondent-appellant is represented by counsel, respondent-appellant and petitioner-respondent are directed to enter their initial information for electronic filing in the New York State Courts Electronic Filing System (NYSCEF) pursuant to section 1245.3 of the Electronic Filing Rules of the Appellate Division, and thereafter electronically file their respective briefs.

The Clerk of Family Court, New York County, is directed to have transcribed the minutes of the proceedings held therein, if any, for inclusion in the record on appeal, with a copy furnished to appellant, the cost thereof to be charged against the City of New York from funds available therefor. The motion is otherwise denied.
